Our most popular and well attended session was the Ukrainian Easter Egg Dying

workshop in conjunction with St. Mary Magdalene Equal to the Apostles. This year we raised over \$1,000.00 to support war relief efforts in Ukraine.







We have found that gathering around a creative endeavor with prayers and reflection time has helped deepen our relationships with one another. Most of our gatherings have included people from multiple generations, and we have learned a lot from each other in these times of gathering and slowing down. We know that there is potential in this ministry and we will continue to offer times for people to gather and create together. We are continuing to explore ways to connect with our neighbors more intentionally with this ministry, and we hope that our September event, Rootstock, will help
