YES CO was honored to host the Episcopal Church in Colorado's Delegation to EYE23 at the University of Maryland this July 2023. EYE is a triannual gathering of youth from around the Episcopal Church, with youth coming from around the US and other countries. A three day event with worship, community, workshops, singing, dancing, fun and so much love. The theme of EYE23 was Regreso A Casa, A New Age of Faith. Our delegation of 19 youth from churches around the diocese and 4 adult leaders, heard a powerful message that young



people are not the future of the church, they are the "Now." The present. Their voice matters and is needed now. They are wonderfully made for "Such a time as this." The story of Esther was the inspiration for many of the talks and reflections we enjoyed during our time at EYE. Esther was a strong women who God called on to be brave in saving her people. A bravery that we can empower our youth to model in the world today.

During our time at EYE23 we heard sermons and reflections from youth, priests, and guests on the importance of the youth voice. We heard about youth positions in our church and our communities. Workshops were available to youth and leaders on so many wonderful topics. Workshops on formation ideas, youth leadership councils, voting information for new voters, suicide prevention, pastoral care in young people, strengthening our faith roots and so much more. As a group we brought back with us a certainty that we are loved by God, our church, our community and each other. We brought back new ideas for sharing our ministry and faith with others and we brought back a lifelong memory of days that will be with us always. An experience these youth will carry with them as they grow into the people God has created them to be.

It is my privilege to work with our young people and I am so honored to have shared this experience with them. I could continue to go on describing our experience but my words will never be as powerful as the words of our youth. In the paragraphs that follow, please find the reflections from our young people who attended as delegates representing The Episcopal Church in Colorado. Please know that this trip and our delegation was well supported by Bishop Kym, the High Plains, Front Range and Sangre de Cristo Regions along with private sponsors from around the diocese and congregations. This trip had a total cost of



\$1,015.00 per person. Thanks to our wonderful supporters, grants, and donations each youth/family paid only \$100.00 per participant. Many families would not have been able to send their youth to this life changing event without this amazing support. As you will read, our appreciation and gratitude is deep and wide. To know we are so loved that this experience was offered to so many. The Episcopal Church in Colorado had one of the largest delegations in attendance. Something we should all

be very proud of. This shows how important our youth are to us.....today!
