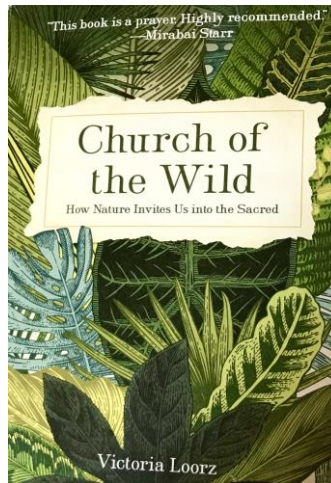


You are invited to participate in a book group this spring!
