

FAQs

Directions: Cathedral Ridge is located at 1364 CR 75 in Woodland Park, 80863. If coming from I-25, take Exit 141 (Cimarron) in Colorado Springs and merge onto US-24 west to Woodland Park. In Woodland Park turn right (north) onto State Highway 67. Go approximately four miles north on Highway 67 to Forest Road 342, which is on the left near mile marker 81. The Cathedral Ridge sign is discreet, but directly across from a prominent Red Rocks Campground Sign. Follow the dirt road approximately a mile to the entrance.

A more scenic (and often faster) route from Denver metro can be taken via 285 south to Pine Junction. Turn south on 126 and drive through Pine and Buffalo Creek to Deckers. Continue south on 67 towards Woodland Park for 19 miles. Near mile marker 81, you'll see a US Forest Service Sign for Red Rocks Campground on the left side. Directly across is the Cathedral Ridge turnoff onto Forest Road 342. Follow the dirt road for a mile to the entrance.

Check-in: Please let Renzi know your ETA on your day of arrival, anytime after 1 pm. As you come through the entrance gate, stop at Rosemary Cottage. Renzi will lead you to your site.

Altitude: At nearly 9,000 feet, dress in layers and plan for all kinds of weather. Bring a water bottle and drink plenty of water. Mild altitude sickness can be alleviated with rest and hydration. Canned oxygen is available upon request.

Amenities: While lodge rooms and cottages are not airconditioned, windows have screens and evenings are quite cool. Fans are available. Frisbees, bicycles, cornhole, a labyrinth and hiking trails are abundant.

Connectivity: Due to our remote location and satellite connection, we cannot offer guest wi-fi. Cell reception is strongest near the Dining Hall. Cottages have TVs with DVD players.

Smoke-free: Cathedral Ridge buildings are a smoke-free environment. Please only smoke outside and away from any facilities.

Food Service: When guest groups are on campus and our dining hall is serving, all guests are invited to eat from our buffet. We are glad to accommodate vegetarian, gluten-free, peanut-free and dairy-free dietary needs.

Campfire ring reservation and s'mores kit: \$50

Individual and family guests are welcome to bring their own food. Cottages have a full kitchen, and lodge rooms have access to a mini-fridge, microwave and toaster oven.

Wilderness awareness: Wildlife is abundant here. Please do not leave food outside or in your cars and keep dogs leashed. Campfires are permitted at camp rings by reservation only to comply with local fire restrictions. Before hiking, tell someone where you are going and when you plan to return, or leave a note.
