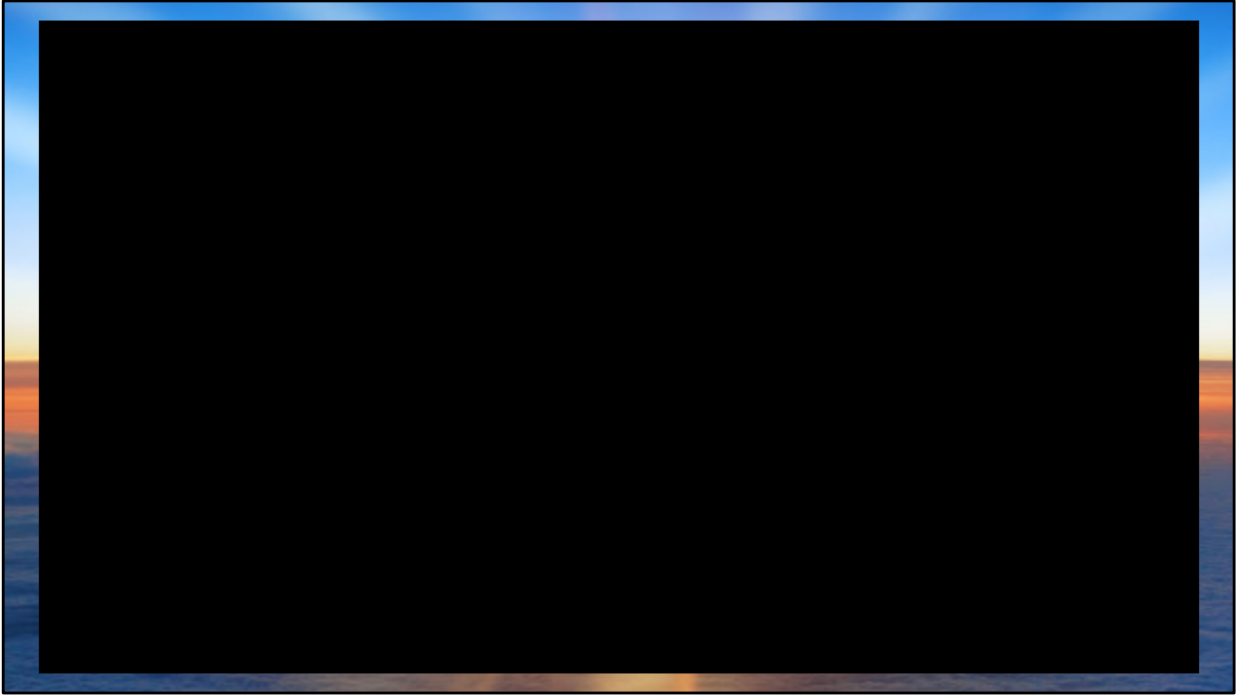

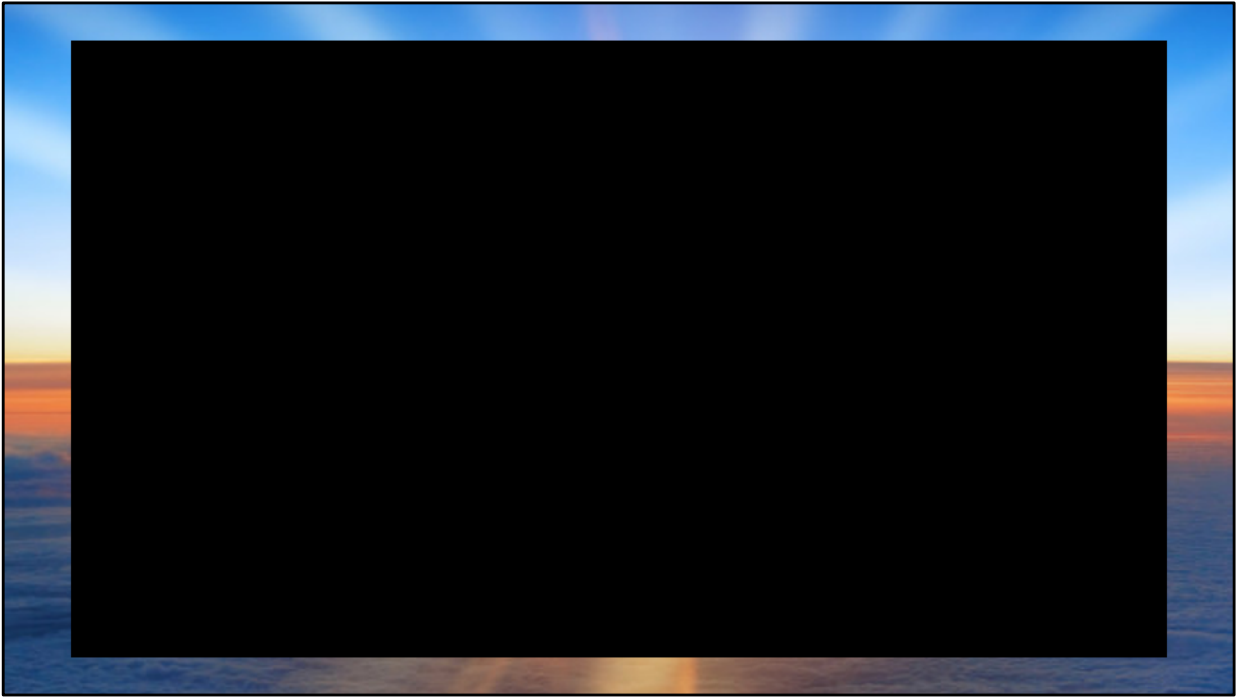


# Word
