Schedule:

A copy of the weekend retreat schedule is located in the welcome packet and can be folded to fit in the nametags. Any adjustments to the schedule will be shared in leader meetings.

Medical Issues:

Meals:

All meals will be served in Mantee, the dining hall at the base of the campus, with the exception of a sack lunch on Sunday. This will be available for pick up just outside the dining hall entrance following the close of Sunday's general session. Please wait outside the entry doors prior to the start of each meal until a designated leader has invited the group to enter.

Clean-up:

A member of the Frontier Ranch staff will direct us in the appropriate clean-up of our lodging spaces at Sunday morning's breakfast. Please assist the facility staff in teaching and supervising your group in this process. In addition, the Quest staff also appreciates the help of one or two youth groups in cleaning-up and packing up the Kichana supplies after the last session on Sunday. If your group can help in this way, please speak to Elizabeth Cervasio. Finally, please ask all your youth to help with picking up litter around the campus before departing on Sunday.
