Ten Years of Colorado ESC

On June 1 of 2023, the Colorado ESC Board voted to suspend the program to discern a more sustainable and equitable model for ministry with young adults. Service year programs are ending or being reinvented around the country as leaders find new ways to be in healthier relationships with the communities they seek to serve and to meet the changing needs of young adults.

The 2022-23 program year was the last year for the Reverend Rebecca Crummey, as Executive Director. After 10 years of leading the corps she is ready to explore new things. She will continue to be part time vicar at St. Peter and St. Mary Church in Denver, the congregation that many corps members over the years have called home.



We ended this year with 3 corps members, 2 who are staying in Denver and one who is attending Creighton University Law School.

Over the years we have had support from so many people: our partner agencies, our funders, formation leaders and spiritual directors. We are so grateful for all of them, without their support, Colorado ESC would never have lasted for 10 years.

Colorado ESC has supported and nurtured 57 corps members. Alumni are spread across the country participating in their local communities as clergy, artists, teachers, social workers, non-profit leaders, therapists and business folks. Over a dozen alumni live in Denver and actively stay in touch with each other, continuing to build courageous community together.
