REPORT ON GRANT FOR PAVING OF ST LAURENCE CHURCH, CONIFER DRIVEWAY

We asked for assistance in repaving our driveway because it had deteriorated to the point that members and prospective members were being discouraged from using it. Two local contractors were asked to bid the job using either recycled asphalt, which would require replacement in a few years, or hot asphalt which would last much longer it properly maintained. Despite the higher cost, we decided to go with the hot asphalt paving, for which Holland and Hurst had the lowest bid of \$35,037. Signage and a speed bump were added to the project at a cost of \$153. Work was completed in June 2023.
