We have had wonderful retreats in the spring and fall and we are almost completely full until Mid-November. Every Retreat we have hosted this year has already been booked for next year. Our staff has done an amazing job serving the guests. Bryn and Beth our Directors of Food Service served incredible food, Ryki, our director of camp operations, made sure the groups needs were met before and during their retreat and Linda, our Deacon, hosted the groups well and shared her love and knowledge of creation. Brian, our director of facilities has worked hard to get our facility ready for all camps and retreats. We all pitched in wherever the need was to make sure the experience of the guests was excellent.

We will continue outrageous hospitality as our staff changes in the coming year. Beth has taken on Bryn's role as Director of Food Service, Ryki will move from hosting to Director of Camp Operations while overseeing hospitality, Brian will be meeting the needs of the groups by providing facility support. There have been new people brought on to help in each of these areas. We are looking to expand our activity offerings for both retreats and summer camp with the possibility of offsite horseback rides, fishing, kayaking, and whitewater rafting. We will continue to offer both low and high ropes as well as archery. We will be training new staff in ropes and archery. We are now booking for spring and fall of 2024.

Youth and Family Camp

We had an amazing summer serving children, youth, and families! God has been moving in their lives as they experienced the love of God in Jesus through the Holy Spirit. We saw families grow closer to one another and to the Lord. We saw children and youth have fun, laugh, and share while making new friends and growing in their relationships with each other and with God.

Elizabeth Cervasio did an amazing job putting together the summer staff and setting up program leaders and chaplains for the youth camps. She also set up the staff training and made sure all the staff were up to date on all the requirements from the state. She took care of all the program needs for each camp by working with each of the leadership teams. Thank you, Elizabeth, for all your hard work this year! Deacon Linda Brown did an incredible job as well preparing family camps with chaplains and leaders. She also hosted many retreats and led the care of creation family camp as well as many of the creation care in each of the camps. Thank you, Linda!

The summer staff did a great job this summer caring for the families and the children and youth at camp. The program leaders and chaplains were excellent and brought a wonderful program for each session.

We are looking forward to sharing videos, pictures, brochures, and an updated website with the current families that enjoyed their time so they can promote the camp to their friends. The best marketing is word of mouth marketing with the help of on-line tools. We will also be hitting the road this fall, winter and spring going to regions and churches building relationships to promote

Cathedral Ridge and to listen to people from around the Diocese. We will also be adding new youth and family camps such as a Sr. High Leadership Camp that will train 16-18yr old high school students to be counselors in training and program crew. We will also add new family camps that will partner with congregations in August. We are working with Missioner QC on a multiethnic family camp that would serve Sudanese, Latino, Indian and others. We believe there will be support for such a camp and it would fit our vision at Cathedral Ridge. We are working to fill up most of the summer with youth and family camps. Come and join us for one of the camps in 2024!

Finally, we will be hiring a program director to plan our programs for the summer and for year-round retreats. The program director will work with the Program Leaders and Chaplains for each session throughout the summer while also providing program planning and support for retreats during the year. I would hope this person could bring a musical gift to lead our children, youth, and adults in singing and worship.

Our goal is to double the number of campers next summer to almost 500 compared to 229 this year. We can do this by building on what God did this past summer and help children, youth and families share their experience with others.

Facilities

Our new facilities director, Brian Carpenter, jumped right into the camp when he started on July 8th. The facilities have had several deferred maintenance needs that will be addressed over time. Some of these issues we can put into our budget but some we will need to seek additional funding.

We are developing a 5-year plan to add to and update our current facility. To make the camp financially viable we need to have room for at least 100 to 120 people in our youth camp, family camp and at our retreats. The Lodge needs to be updated, a new lodge building added, three flexible cabins that can be used for youth, families, or adults built and the current youth cabins repurposed. We are looking to add a multi-purpose covered pavilion, a playground, and a hardscaped seating area outside Lupine Lodge as well. We have a committee of the board beginning to work on this process to develop a plan for 2024.
