

Grant Report to the Front Range Region Of the Episcopal Diocese of Colorado

Thanks to the \$17,723 in funding that was received from the Front Range Region, the east and west parking lots at Holy Comforter Episcopal Church in Broomfield are once again welcoming, safe spaces for visitors and members alike. Due to a combination of inattention during the COVID epidemic and financial constraints, the parking lots suffered greatly in both appearance and function. Cracks in the pavement developed into deep crevices and failing asphalt, which directly impacted safety and accessibility to church facilities.



In late fall of 2024, Mountain States Asphalt Paving, Inc. completed asphalt patchwork on several areas in the east and west parking lots. The cost of this project was \$6,810. It was paid from Holy Comforter's fledgling long-term maintenance account. In July, 2025, Mike Sealcoat completed several smaller surface



patchwork areas and did crack fill and joint sealing in preparation for sealcoating both lots in September. The cost of the crack fill and joint sealing was \$11,136, which was paid for with Front Range Region grant funds. The estimated cost of seal coating both lots is \$7,288, to be paid for with funds from the Front Range Region grant. Any remaining amount for seal coating and striping will be paid from Holy Comforter's long-term maintenance fund.

We wish to thank the Front Range Region for your continued support of, and commitment to, Holy Comforter over many years. Holy Comforter's members and Vestry are extremely grateful that Front

Range Region grant funds enabled us to proactively work on repairing a problem that increased in severity and importance with the passage of time, creating a safe and navigable space for all who come to our campus. We are diligently working to improve our self-sufficiency by depositing funds into our long-term maintenance account monthly. The Front Range Region grant funds that Holy Comforter received are literally getting our church out of a hole!
