Our History at Holy Comforter



Welcoming usher

From the basement of a small house serving as a chapel, Holy Comforter continued to grow. A three acre lot was purchased in 1962, along what was a country road on the far west side of Broomfield, and it remains our location today. Groundbreaking took place on May 17, 1964, with music from a piano in the back of a pickup truck foretelling our love of music. Our original pipe organ was built from scratch by our first warden. The goal set in 1958 had become a reality.

Holy Comforter Episcopal Church's roots began in 1958 when twelve families met in the basement of a home in the little town of Broomfield, Colorado. They could not have possibly known they were laying the foundation for the faith community we now know as Holy Comforter. Beyond the buildings erected through the years, it was something special, stronger; a community in faith and numbers. It became the place we know and call our spiritual home.

Our History at Holy Comforter

In 2001, we built a beautiful new sanctuary and parish hall, encumbering us with a million-dollar mortgage. Then, like many Episcopal churches, Holy Comforter began to struggle with issues around human sexuality and, in 2007, nearly half our congregation left when our priest disagreed with the direction of the National Church. Weakened, we moved to mission status. With strong leadership and the support of the region and diocese, we began to rebuild. In 2016, Holy Comforter regained parish status, adding staff and ministries that incorporated new members and involvement in the community.

The time of COVID was a challenge, complicated by transition in clergy leadership. We found ourselves emerging from that time needing to re-group and recover in many ways - spiritually, relationally, and financially. We went to work on all three, with the first two still being a work in progress. Following a major year of financial rebuilding in 2023, we were blessed when parishioners stepped forward with gifts to pay off the \$650,000 mortgage, enabling us to grow our ministries and call the person we need to lead us. This reduction in debt has given us the grace to dream creatively about where we are heading next, and we are looking forward to calling the person to walk this journey with us.
