This summer 19 children came to camp- a small but significant increase. We had the camp a bit later in June so that all the school districts around us were out of school. All but one of the families who attended last summer and we had 5 new families including several from the community. This year we focused recruitment by paying for a Facebook ad and banner, as well as posting on various websites.

We again had a strong core of volunteers from the church both who helped regularly and who offered different activities. We went hiking, swimming, did dance and music and had arts and crafts and Bible study. The kids really enjoyed it! As happened last year, all the kids and parents wanted to know why we don't offer camp every week. And by the end of the week, the volunteers were glad it was only once a week!
