Thanks to your generous funding, St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in Grand Junction, Colorado, has been able to strengthen its partnership with the nonprofit group, Solidarity Not Charity, to help support their food pantry program. This pantry meets people where they are, on the street, to deliver food to some of the most chronically unhoused in the Mesa County area. Through this grant fund, nearly 9,000 lbs of food have been distributed.

Solidarity Not Charity has expended \$3,953.20 of the grant through July 16, 2026. The remaining funds, \$2,046.80, are expected to be expended over the next two to three months. Solidarity Not Charity remains the only food pantry available each and every Saturday in the Mesa County area. The organization does not require any proof of need to receive goods, nor is there a limit to the number of times an individual can visit our pantry. During a time when food insecurity is at an all time high, your support has meant that our hungry neighbors can receive high-quality shelf stable food.
